## Compound sentence

A compound sentence is made up of two or more independent clauses.

We can use a coordinating conjunction: for, and, but, or, so to join in independent clauses.

## Mai bought many books, <br> Mai likes reading.

We can use a conjunctive adverb: however, therefore, otherwise to join in independent clauses.

Mark is hard working

Mark usually gets high scores on exams.

Mark rất chăm chỉ, thế nên anh ấy luôn đạt điểm cao trong các bài kiểm tra.
...; therefore,...: thế nên
...; however,...: tuy nhiên
...; otherwise,...: nếu không thì
