# Question words before to-infinitives

Minh **asked** me **what to do** to help  
the community.

**what + to V**



**Question words + to infinitives (to V)**



**ask, wonder, (not) decide, (not) tell, or  
(not) know BEFORE the question word +  
to-infinitive.**

# Phrasal verbs (1)



Traditional crafts are often **passed down** from generation to generation to preserve cultural heritage of a community.



Minh

passed down (phrasal verb)

Verb

+

Particle

(tiểu từ: giới từ/  
mạo từ/ phó từ)

# Phrasal verbs (Cụm động từ)



A **phrasal verb** consists of **a verb** and **one or two particles**, such as **up, down, back, on, round, ...**



A phrasal verb usually has **a special meaning.**



# Phrasal verbs (Cụm động từ)



*Example:*

**go out** = *leave your house to go to a social event*  
(đi chơi...)

**pass down** = *give or teach something to your children* (truyền lại)

**cut down on** = *reduce the amount or number of something* (giảm bớt đi)

**run out of** = *have no more of* (hết/ cạn kiệt...)
