La Tomatina, a famous festival where participants throw tomatoes at each other purely for fun. Thousands of people from around the world gather to take part in this unique and messy event.























Countable Nouns

Countable nouns are nouns that we can count.

singular form

plural form

• They refer to objects, people, or things that can be individually identified and quantified.





Countable Nouns





+ countable noun



a single item

specific quantities



an apple

many apples





Uncountable Nouns

Uncountable nouns are nouns that we can't count.



• Countable nouns can have only a singular form.







Uncountable Nouns

• They refer to substances, concepts, or qualities that are considered to be a whole or mass.

quantifiers +

(much, some, any, ...)
