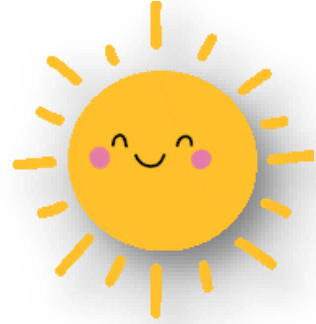

Countable Nouns

- Countable nouns are nouns that we can count.



- They refer to objects, people, or things that can be individually identified and quantified.

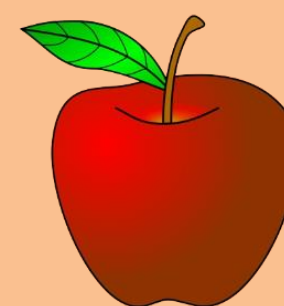
Countable Nouns

□ a / an + countable noun

EXAMPLES



a cat



an apple



a single item

□ numbers / quantifiers + countable noun

(a few, few, many, any, ...)

EXAMPLES



seven cats



many apples



specific quantities



Uncountable Nouns

- Uncountable nouns are nouns that we can't count.

Can you count milk?

NO!



- Countable nouns can have only a singular form.

~~milks~~



Uncountable Nouns

- They refer to substances, concepts, or qualities that are considered to be a whole or mass.

□ quantifiers +
(much, some, any, ...)

uncountable noun

EXAMPLES



some / much rice



some / much time

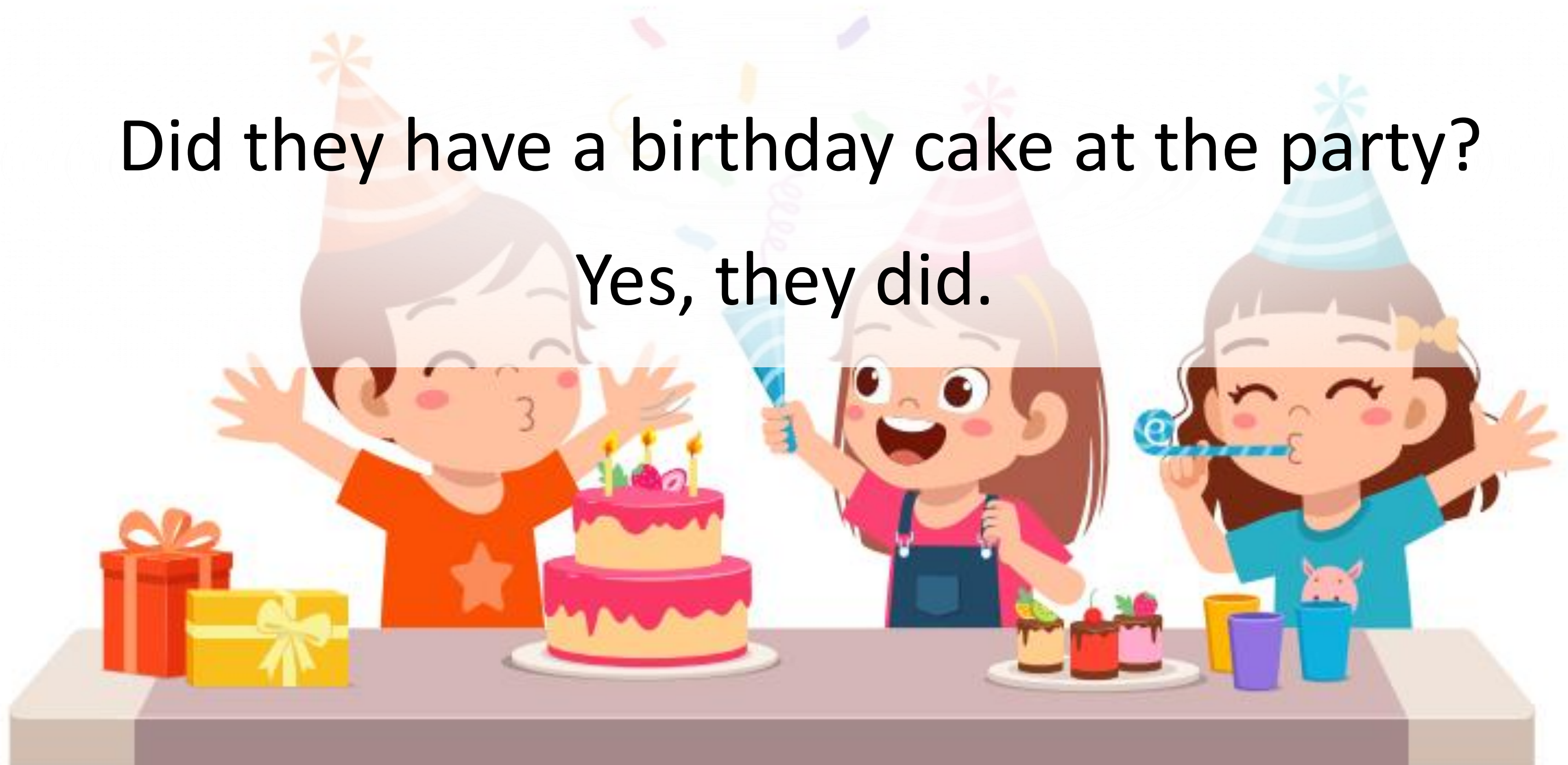
