# Present simple tense



- We use the present simple to talk about:
  - habits, things that we do regularly (daily routine)

Example: I go to school every day.

- facts, things that are always or usually true:

Example: The Earth goes around the sun.

- every day/ week/ month/ year
- once/ twice/ three times a week
- in the morning/ afternoon/ evening
- on Monday/ Tuesday/ Saturday
- always/ usually/ often/ sometimes/ never
