



Use Falling Intonation In...

- 1. Declarative sentences --> I live in France.
- 2. Commands --> Sit down!
- Exclamatory sentences --> What a wonderful girl!
- 4. At the last item of a list --> I like cars, trucks and BIKES.
- 5. Wh questions --> Where do you live?
- Tag question --> You live in France, DON'T YOU?
 (It's not a real question, you already know the answer. You just want to confirm it or are just making conversation.)

Use Rising Intonation In...

- 1. Yes/No questions --> Are you French?
- In every item of list except the last one --> I like CARS, TRUCKS and bikes.
- Dependent or introductory sentences --> IF SHE CALLS, ask her to come.
- Direct address --> SIR, be careful with the dog.
- Tag questions --> You live in France, DON'T YOU? (Here the tag question is a real question because you don't know the answer).


