

You will see the Statue of Liberty.

She will have a party next month.

We will meet at the restaurant.

We use **not** to make the negative future form. The short form of **will not** is **won't**.

I will not fly to New York next week.

You will not see the Statue of Liberty.

She will not have a party next month.

We will not meet at the restaurant.

If you plan to do something in the near future, use **going to**. A be-verb must come before **going to** and the base verb must come after **going to**.

I am going to do my homework.

You are going to sing with her.

He is going to play soccer.

They are going to have pizza for dinner.

We use **not** to make the negative form of **be going to**.

You are not going to sing with her.

He is not going to play soccer.

- Today is hotter than yesterday.
- This test is more difficult than the last one.
- ▶ She seems happier than before.

For adjectives with one syllable, add -er.	long	longer
For adjectives that end in one vowel followed by a consonant, double the consonant. Then add -er .	hot	hotter
For adjectives that end in y, change y to i and add -er .	happy	happi <mark>er</mark>
For adjectives with two or more syllables, just write more before the adjective.	difficult	more difficult
